# CERTIFICATE IN PHOTOJOURNALISM (3 MONTH COURSE)



The Certificate Course in Photojournalism is a three-month program focused on the art and technique of visual storytelling. The course combines classroom instruction with field assignments to help students develop a professional-quality portfolio.
